Of immediate concern are the health and safety issues surrounding the defunct Sportsman’s Cove mobile home park. When these issues are resolved the parcel will then have a major development proposed by the owner, the Renzi Trust. The Alliance recognizes the increasing pressure for development on both sides of the river. An explosion in the areas number of planned travel trailer spaces threatens significant congestion and disruption.

The meeting will be at 7pm at the Homosassa Civic Club on Thursday, the 19th of November. The club is across the street from the Homosassa elementary school. The public is urged to attend and become involved in the protection of our river. You are welcome even if you are not a member. We consider any ideas that may help us restore and reclaim our rivers.
